

VIRGINIA: IN THE COUNTY OF DINWIDDIE.

At an informal joint meeting of the Boards of Supervisors of Dinwiddie County and Prince George County held in the Clerk's Office of Dinwiddie County on March 2nd, 1962 at 10 o'clock A. M. the following informal agreement was reached upon motion duly made, seconded and unanimously passed:

That the County line between the County of Dinwiddie and the County of Prince George extending from the City limits of the City of Petersburg on the north to the Sussex County line on the south as indicated and laid out by the representatives of the Department of Taxation on aerial maps presented to the meeting and to be finally indicated on a permanent map to be prepared by the Department of Taxation is the true and correct location of the said county line as established by commissioners appointed for the purpose in the year 1901 by the Courts of both Counties and as indicated by the original plats prepared by the said commissioners and recorded in the Clerk's Office of said Counties.
