There is no allocation, or designation of any funds of this county for any purpose until there has been an appropriation for that purpose by the Board of Supervisors. A hearing will be held by the Board of Supervisors on the budget for informative purposes at the Agricultural Building on the 4th day of May, 1962 at 2:00 P.M., at which time any citizens of this county shall have the right to attend and state his views. The budget is for informative and fiscal planning purposes and will not be approved, adopted, or ratified by the Board of Supervisors.
