Upon motion duly made and carried the Clerk is directed to purchase a seperate plat book in which will be recorded all plats of Subdivisions.


IN RE: ADDING MACHINE FOR CLERK'S OFFICE.


IN RE: INVENTORY TO BE FILED BY COUNTY OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS.
