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IN RE: ALLOWANCE OF CLAIMS AND SALARIES.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered by the Board that the salaries and accounts against the General Revenue Fund of the County for the month of June, 1962, amounting to \$ be allowed and checks numbering 2878 through 2977, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the General Revenue Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: ALLOWANCE AGAINST THE DOG FUND OF THE COUNTY.

On motion duly made and carried, it is ordered that a salary of \$166.66 be paid to the Dog Warden and that \$105.00 be paid to him as mileage for the month of June, and that claims amounting to \$18.75 be paid out of the Dog Fund of the County for the month of June, 1962, and checks numbering D-184 through D-190, both inclusive, be issued, therefor, payable out of the said Dog Fund of the County, said claims having been audited and approved by the Board.

IN RE: TREASURER'S REPORT.

F. E. Jones, treasurer having submitted a written financial report, same was ordered filed with the papers of the Board for the month of July, 1962.

IN RE: CHURCH ROAD ELEMENTARY SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION BIDS.

Bids having been presented for the construction of Church Road Elementary School at the regular meeting of this Board held on June 1, 1962, and

This Board by resolution having tabled action on the bids,

On motion duly made and carried hereby approves the low bid of \$271,970.00 submitted by Mottley Construction Company and accepted by the Dinwiddie County School Board with the provision that 25% of the funds will not be payable until April 15, 1963.

IN RE: RESOLUTION OF APPRECIATION TO MR. W. A. SCARBOROUGH.

Mr. W. A. Scarborough, Superintendent of Schools, having retired as of June 30th,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Chairman of the Board and the Clerk submit an appropriate resolution of appreciation for his services to the County.

IN RE: NAMOZINE FIRE DEPARTMENT - REQUEST FOR 2/25 LB. CHEMICAL FIRE EXTINGUISHERS.

Namozine Fire Department having submitted a request for 2/25 lb. chemical fire extinguishers, the Clerk was directed to secure prices and submit same at the next Board meeting.

IN RE: W. A. CANADA SUBDIVISION PLAT.

Mr. W. A. Canada having submitted a plat of 1.27 acres on Route 603 and it appearing that there is some question as to the drainage along Route 603,

Motion was duly made and carried that action on this plat be tabled until further report by the State Highway Department.

IN RE: ASC OFFICE LEASE JULY 1, 1962 THROUGH JUNE 30, 1963.

Motion was duly made and carried that the lease for the ASC office consisting of 1356 square feet of office space located in the Agricultural Building containing four rooms and a lobby for an annual rental of \$1,008.00 per year payable \$84.00 per month be renewed, same to be executed by M. G. Chandler, Chairman.

IN RE: LETTER TO DINWIDDIE COUNTY FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

The Board having appropriated \$500.00 each for Namozine, Ford, and Dinwiddie Fire Departments and \$250.00 for Carson Fire Department the Clerk is instructed to write these fire Departments and request that they please stay within the amount that had been appropriated for their department during the year as the County is operating on a very close budget.

IN RE: BARNES AND SPAIN PLAT FOR W. P. GODWIN SR.

A plat of two lots containing one acre and two acres respectively of property acquired by W. P. Godwin Sr. having been presented for approval by this Board and it appearing that this property is on secondary road and has been approved by the Department of Health,

On motion duly made and carried same is approved by this Board and the Clerk is directed to record the plat when so requested.

IN RE: REQUEST FOR STREET SIGNS.

A request having been submitted to the Board to erect street signs in some of the Subdivisions,

Upon motion duly made and carried action on this request is tabled until a further study can be made of the requested signs.

IN RE: NUMBERS OF HOUSES, NAMOZINE SUBDIVISIONS.

The postmaster of Petersburg Post Office having suggested that the houses in the subdivisions from Petersburg City Limits along Route 460 and U. S. Route 1 to and including Route 603 be numbered in order that they may be served by City delivery,

Motion was duly made and carried that no action be taken on this.

IN RE: CUTTING GRASS ON COURT HOUSE GREEN.

It appearing that at times there are no trustees to cut the grass at the Court House green,

Motion was duly made and carried that the Clerk be directed to hire local labor to keep the lawn cut when necessary.

IN RE: 1963 POLICE CAR BIDS.

Upon motion duly made and carried, the Sheriff is directed to secure bids on 1963 Ford, Chevrolet and Plymouth police cars for trade-in and straight purchase.

IN RE: HOSPITAL CONTRACTS FOR INDIGENT PATIENTS.

Mr. C. H. Zehmer having submitted contracts with Petersburg General Hospital and Medical College of Virginia to provide hospitalization and treatment of indigent or medically indigent persons, said contract subject to termination upon thirty days written notice by either party or the Department of Welfare and Institutions.

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Motion was duly made and carried that the contracts be executed by the Chairman of the Board with Petersburg General Hospital at the rate of \$21.60 per day and Medical College of Virginia at the rate of \$24.65 per day.

IN RE: HEATING SYSTEM - COURT HOUSE, CLERK'S OFFICE AND JAIL.

Upon motion duly made and carried the Clerk is directed to request bids for replacing the present heating system in the basement of the Courthouse with individual heating systems for the Court House and the jail and further directed to contact Virginia Electric & Power Company requesting installation costs of heating the Clerk's Office electrically.

IN RE: REQUEST FOR SECURITY MICROFILM OF CLERK'S RECORDS.

H. B. Batte, Clerk having requested the Board of Supervisors upon the recommendation of the State Archivist to allow him to have the old deed and will records microfilmed for security purposes,

Motion was duly made and carried that this request be refused at this time.

IN RE: STREET LIGHTS - WESTERN HILLS SUBDIVISION.

A petition from Joseph C. Holloway and others having been received requesting that at least five street lights be erected in Western Hills Subdivision,

Upon motion duly made and carried M. G. Chandler is requested to meet with a representative of Virginia Electric & Power Company to investigate the need of these street lights and report at the next Board meeting. It is further moved that the Clerk secure from the League of Virginia Counties all information available concerning the furnishing of street lights in subdivisions by the County.

IN RE: CIVIL DEFENSE DIRECTOR AND CO-ORDINATOR, RESIGNATIONS ACCEPTED.

Mr. T. J. Leftwich and Mr. A. Mitchell Smith, Civil Defense Director and Co-ordinator, respectively, having submitted their resignations,

Motion was duly made and carried that their resignations be accepted with regrets and the Board extends to them their appreciation for the fine work they have done.

✓ IN RE: DONATION TO PIEDMONT SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT.

Mr. J. E. Dodson, Member of the Piedmont Soil Conservation District Board having appeared before the Board and requested \$250.00 from this County along with the same amount from Nottoway, Amelia, Powhatan and Prince Edward to purchase needed office equipment and furniture,

Upon motion duly made and carried the Clerk is directed to issue check payable to Lee Palmer, Treasurer, Route 4, Powhatan Court House, for \$250.00.
